**20 Meaningful Activities Every Muslim Can Do**  
***Simple Ways to Share the Prophet's ﷺ Message with People of Other Faiths***

The message of Prophet Muhammad ﷺ was one of **mercy, compassion, justice, peace and service to humanity**.

This Rabi-ul-Awwal, let us celebrate by becoming ambassadors of his beautiful character and reaching out to our brothers and sisters of other faiths.

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**1. Invite Someone Home**

Invite a non-Muslim friend, neighbour, colleague or classmate to your home for tea, dinner or a simple family gathering.

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**2. Celebrate Eid-e-Milad Together**

Share sweets, food or small gifts with your non-Muslim neighbours and friends as a gesture of love and goodwill.

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**3. Invite Them to a Seerah Program**

Take someone to a Seerah lecture, Milad gathering, exhibition or cultural event where they can learn about the Prophet ﷺ.

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**4. Organize a Masjid Parichay**

Invite people of other faiths to visit your local mosque, understand its purpose, observe the prayer hall and interact with community members.

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**5. Gift a Seerah Book**

Present a simple book, booklet or pamphlet about the life and universal teachings of Prophet Muhammad ﷺ.

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**6. Visit Hospitals Together**

Visit a government hospital with fruits, flowers or essential items and spread hope through kindness and compassion.

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**7. Participate in Blood Donation**

Donate blood or volunteer at a Blood Donation Camp and encourage friends from all communities to participate together.

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**8. Serve the Community**

Organize or join food distribution, water distribution, medical camps or relief activities that benefit everyone without distinction.

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**9. Plant Trees Together**

Plant trees or gift plants with neighbours, schools or community groups as a shared commitment to protecting the environment.

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### **10. Clean Your Neighbourhood**

Participate in cleanliness drives in public places, parks, beaches, schools or markets and inspire civic responsibility.

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### **11. Meet Community Leaders**

Visit teachers, principals, doctors, journalists, police officers, social workers and local leaders to introduce the campaign and its objectives.

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### **12. Appreciate Everyday Heroes**

Thank sanitation workers, security guards, nurses, drivers, municipal workers and other frontline workers with flowers, appreciation cards or refreshments.

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### **13. Organize an Interfaith Tea Meeting**

Invite a small group of neighbours or friends from different faiths for informal conversation, mutual learning and friendship.

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### **14. Share the Prophet's Universal Teachings**

Post short quotes, videos or stories about the Prophet ﷺ's teachings on mercy, honesty, justice and compassion on social media.

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### **15. Help Someone in Need**

Support a poor family, orphan, widow, elderly person or student without expecting anything in return.

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### **16. Visit Old Age Homes and Orphanages**

Spend time with senior citizens and orphaned children, distribute gifts and share moments of care and compassion.

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### **17. Organize a "Lunch with My Neighbour"**

Invite one non-Muslim family to share a meal and build lasting friendships through personal interaction.

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### **18. Become a Volunteer**

Join the #ProphetForAll Campaign as a volunteer and help organize local outreach activities in your city.

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### **19. Introduce the Campaign to One Institution**

Encourage your school, college, office, NGO, housing society or professional association to organize at least one activity under the campaign.

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### **20. Inspire Ten More People**

Encourage your family members, relatives and friends to each undertake one meaningful activity and become ambassadors of the Prophet's ﷺ message.
